- And a belated Thank You to Bob Rumsby for the Norwich City Football Tickets he kindly donated to the school community.

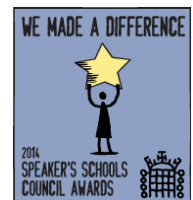

Yr 1/2 - **Alex** for doing brilliant number work and a fantastic acrostic poem this week!

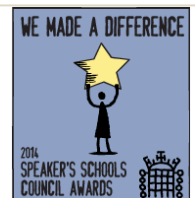
Yr 3/4 - The **whole class** for engaging so enthusiastically during their visit to Norwich Cathedral.
